

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 - 1984

TOWN OF MUNDA

A LOCAL LAW, TOWN OF MUNDA, TO ABOLISH THE JOINT VILLAGE AND TOWN OF MUNDA POLICE DEPARTMENT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MUNDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I: The joint police department established in the Village and Town of Nunda as provided by §121-a of the General Municipal Law shall be abolished upon the adoption of the proposition submitted at the next general election to be held in the Town of Nunda.

Section II: This local law shall be submitted by a proposition at the general election to be held on November 6, 1984 between the hours of 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. E.S.T.

Section III: If this Local Law No. 1 of 1984 becomes effective then the joint police department shall be abolished on January 1, 1986.

Section IV: This Local Law shall become effective if a majority of the votes cast on the proposition submitted be in the affirmative and on the day this Local Law No. 1 of 1984 is filed in the offices of the Secretary of the State of New York.
