

TOWN OF NUNDA LOCAL LAW NO. 2
of the Year 1981

Local Law Governing Special Police Officers of the Nunda Police Department in the Town of Nunda. Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Nunda, Livingston County, as follows:

SECTION I. Special Police Officers of the Town of Nunda Police Department, as duly organized under the authority of Section 8-800 of the General Municipal Law, shall be and hereby are deemed to be public servants as such term is used in the Criminal Procedure Law of the State of New York for the purposes of issuing parking tickets and appearance tickets returnable to the Town or Village courts of Nunda provided that the tickets are issued while the Special Police Officer is in the presence of a Police Officer. Parking tickets and appearance tickets issued by such Special Police Officers shall be in the same form as those designated for use by the regularly appointed and constituted officers of the Town of Nunda Police Department. Use of such parking tickets and appearance tickets by such Special Police Officers shall be solely within the jurisdiction of the Chief of Police. Such designation of Special Police Officers as public servants for the purposes set forth shall not be deemed to confer upon such Special Police Officers any additional powers, duties or responsibilities other than set forth herein.

SECTION II. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
