PRELIMINARY BUDGET Supervisor Walker addressed the 2019 Preliminary Town of Nunda budget that shall be passed as the adopted 2019 Budget.

ADOPTION OF BUDGET Motion was made to pass the preliminary budget as the 2019 adopted Town budget. Motion was made by Jim Forrester, seconded by Mike Hillier and carried 5-0.

PLOW ACCIDENT The board briefly discussed the accident on Friday, November 16th at the Government Center Parking lot with 550 dump truck.

 Rick was plowing around 7:45 am and backed into one of the pillars holding up the awning to the handicap lift. The hit pillar has been completely removed and the second pillar is cracked and damaged.

 Mark Mullikin brought Brian Kelley to install a temporary beam to support the awning and re-secure the drainage pipes that were also broken during the accident.

 The Town insurance company has been given all the information and they are beginning the process of claims for the Government Center.

DALTON LIGHTING It was recently reported that the Hamlet of Dalton had nine of their street lights out last week. Half have been restored by RG&E and has already greatly improved visibility.
