

## SCHEDULE A

1. The Town of Nunda is authorized to create, by a cooperative agreement with the Village of Nunda, a joint Planning Board consisting of seven members to be appointed as follows:

One member of the Planning Board shall hold office for a one year term and shall be appointed by the Town Board of the Town of Nunda. Two members of the Planning Board shall hold office for two year terms, one of whom shall be appointed by the Town Board of the Town of Nunda and the other of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Village of Nunda, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Nunda. Two members of the Planning Board shall hold office for three year terms, one of whom shall be appointed by the Town Board of the Town of Nunda and the other of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Village of Nunda, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Nunda. Two members of the Planning Board shall hold office for four year terms, one of whom shall be appointed by the Town Board of the Town of Nunda and the other of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Village of Nunda, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Nunda. Upon the expiration of the terms of office of the initial members of the joint Planning Board, the successors shall be appointed for five year terms which appointments shall be made by whomever appointed the predecessor in office. If a vacancy occurs, other than by expiration of the term of office, the vacancy shall be filled by whomever appointed the member creating the vacancy for the balance of that term. The joint Planning Board shall annually elect a chairman and secretary from its membership and prescribe rules for its conduct.

2. The Town Board of the Town of Nunda shall have the power to remove members appointed by the Town of Nunda, subject to the provisions of 271 of the Town Law of the State of New.

3. Upon the effective date of both this local law and the Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement to be executed with the Village of Nunda, the existing Planning Board of the Town of Nunda shall be abolished and all matters currently pending before the Planning Board of the Town of Nunda shall be transferred to the joint Planning Board.

4. This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.
