

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 - 1974

TOWN OF NUNDA

A LOCAL LAW, TOWN OF NUNDA, TO CHANGE TO SINGLE APPOINTED ASSESSOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF NUNDA AS FOLLOWS

Section I: Local Law No. 1 - 1970 of the Town of Nunda entitled "A Local Law, Town of Nunda, to Provide For the Continued Election of Assessors" is hereby repealed.

Section II: As of January 1, 1975 the office of assessor in the Town of Nunda shall become an appointed position as provided by Section 1522 and Section 1557 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, and a single assessor shall be appointed.

Section III: This local law shall be submitted at a general election to be held on November 5, 1974 from the hours of 6:00^{A.M.} to 9:00 P.M.E.D.T.

Section IV: This local law shall become effective if the majority of votes cast on the proposition submitted be in the affirmative and on the day this Local Law No. 1 is filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
