She noted that the biggest change was on page four which showed the Principal and Interest figures for the Highway Garage Bond repayment; \$30,000.00 toward principal and \$55,313.00 toward interest. She also pointed out that the PILOT payment from Once Again Nut Butter nearly doubled from \$7,539.00 last year, to \$15,031.00 for 2023.

Estimates are still needed from contractors on the Government Center building repairs so that we can have accurate amounts for the 2023 budget.

There was a motion to adjourn the meeting made by Councilperson Forrester, seconded by Councilperson Hillier and carried 5-0.
